Chair Diane Mc called meeting to order at 7:00 pm, Opened meeting with Serenity Prayer

Old Business: Reports:

Chair Diane reported that several CMI chair positions remain open: Office Coordinator, Treasurer, The Buzz Newsletter, CPC/PI, Activities, and CMI Liaison. Members are encouraged to announce these openings at meetings and home group business meetings, and to invite sponsees and other members who meet the sobriety requirements to consider serving. These chair positions offer valuable service opportunities. Anyone interested may call the office for more information or attend a CMI meeting, held on the second Thursday of each month. Next month's meeting is Thursday, July 9, 2026, from 7:00 to 8:00 pm.

Alternate Chair Sue M thanked Nancy J for her dedicated service as CMI Treasurer over the past five to six years. She emphasized that while sponsorship is important, service within the AA business structure is also greatly needed. In addition to filling CMI chair positions, every AA group in the Verde Valley needs IGRs (intergroup representatives) and GSRs (group service representatives) to help support AA business throughout the Verde Valley, rather than relying on only a few members to do the work.

Phone Coordinator Tammy - still logging in for a couple of volunteers; we filled Sun 12-4pm shift; still needing to fill W and Th 4-10pm; M 6am-Noon and M 4-10pm. Please call the

Literature Chair Mike C – We have close to two cases of plain language Big Books now; regular Big Book prices are up to \$15 from \$12; we are low on Grapevine books - keep in mind they make great gifts.

Web Servant Chris D – the website is good; people are just calling him about meeting changes. M, T, Th 5:30pm meetings at Spectrum will be moving to the hospital location in July. Chris will post the open CMI Chair positions and descriptions on the website this month.

Meeting List Coordinator Tammy - M, T, Th 5:30 pm meetings at Spectrum will be moving to the hospital as of July - Small Brown Education Building off of Willard St called the Cholla Room; Saturday Candlelight meeting at 9pm will stay at Spectrum; new meeting schedule will be coming out in August.

New Business: IGR Reports:

LaBett attended her first CMI meeting as the new IGR for the Chrysalis Group women's meeting in Sedona. She recently moved from Louisiana and asked whether CMI offers a Back to Basics workshop for newcomers, like the one offered there. Stephanie explained that CMI does not currently offer one, but she has led the workshop for women in her home group. She encouraged LaBett to bring the idea to her home group to see if they would be interested in hosting it.

Mike Mc - Eye Opener Cottonwood – they have a lot of men from Steps to Recovery who attend this meeting; their attendance is very important to the group; it was decided to buy a subscription to the Grapevine at the last business meeting.

Bill R reported that the Camp Verde Group will increase the percentage of its monthly “pie” contribution to GSO because of GSO's current financial needs. The group is also interested in the Plain Language Big Book, so he will get a copy to review and see how it works. The Camp Verde Annual Picnic at the River will be held Saturday, June 13, 2026, at Beasley Flats in Camp Verde. All are welcome; food will be provided. Come jump in the river and cool off!

Treasurer Nancy J reported that CMI has exceeded its \$8,000 prudent reserve and asked the group for input on what percentages should be sent to Area 03 and GSO. After discussion, and because of GSO's current financial difficulties, Chris made a motion to send 75% to GSO and 25% to Area 03. Bill seconded the motion, and it passed

Alternate Chair Sue M asked whether Camp Verde's meeting location is an Alano Club. Bill said it is not, but the group donates to the Camp Verde Library as rent payment to the City. Sue also noted that some Sedona groups have significant funds and pay rent at Stutz Bearcat, which is not an Alano Club either.
